

## 2011 Texas Chargers Art Show Entry Form

This year we are inviting individuals with CHARGE to enter a special exhibit of art which will be hung at the 2011 Texas Chargers Annual Retreat. We will have a special area set aside for exhibit space, and each entrant will receive a ribbon for participation. We want to encourage teachers, families and students to celebrate the joy of creativity and share their creations with others.

1. All entrants must have be individuals with CHARGE syndrome.
2. All work must be original, not created from a kit, coloring book, or reproduced line drawings.
3. All paintings or drawings must be mounted using matte board, foam core board, or poster board.
4. Sculpture must be freestanding, preferably enclosed in a shadow box or other means of display.
5. A current digital photograph of the artist, a digital photo of the art work itself, and a short biographical sketch of the artist must be submitted along with the entry form. This information is used for website information on the exhibit.
6. Release information signed by the parent or guardian must be included with the student registration.
7. Each piece of artwork submitted must have an entry form attached.
8. If artwork has more than one artist, each artist will be required to meet all entry requirements complete individual registration forms
9. Registration forms must be received by February October 28, 2011. Please email entry registration forms to: Holly Cooper at [hollycooper@tsbvi.edu](mailto:hollycooper@tsbvi.edu)
10. Artwork must be hand-delivered to the exhibit location at Camp Allen Friday November 4. If an artist is from a family not attending the conference, they may make arrangements for another family or friend to deliver it.
11. Persons submitting art work are responsible for retrieving their work before they leave, or making arrangements for a friend or family member to do so.

Artwork will not be considered unless the above requirements are met.
