## What is Charge Syndrome?

CHARGE is an extremely complex syndrome, involving extensive medical and physical difficulties that differ from child to child. The acronym "CHARGE" comes from the first letter of some of the most common features seen in this syndrome:

- C Coloboma of the eye & cranial nerve abnormalities
- H Heart malformations
- A Artresia or stenosis of the choanae
- R Retardation of growth or development
- G Genital or urinary abnormalities
- E Ear abnormalities
